What is a screening rate?


The colorectal cancer screening rate is the percentage of eligible people who have completed a FIT test in the last two years.





SO WHAT?

Colorectal cancer screening tests could find cancer early, before you experience symptoms; they could save your life.

PROTECT YOURSELF

Colorectal cancer screening tests should be a part of a person's health routine until they are at least 75 years old.

GET TESTED

All men and women age 50 to 74 years should complete a FIT test every 1 to 2 years. The test is available at community health centres.
