

Statutory Appointments of Child Protection Workers

The Child Protection Worker shall be granted the statutory appointment of a Child Protection Worker under the *Child and Family Services Act* by the Director of Child and Family Services.

REFERENCE

NWT Child and Family Services Act, section 54(2)

PURPOSE

- To provide the legal authority required to fulfill the duties outlined in the *Act*.

PROCEDURE

The Director will:


1. Provide Child Protection Worker Statutory training on a quarterly basis throughout the year or as needed.
2. Appoint any Child Protection Worker who received 70% on the final exam as a Child Protection Worker.
3. Appoint any Child Protection Worker who received less than 70% on the final exam and has an approved professional development training plan in place to increase required competencies, as a Child Protection Worker.

The Supervisor will:

1. Submit the *Recommendation for a Child Protection Worker Statutory Appointment form* to the Director of Child and Family Services, for any Registered or Licensed Social Worker who received 70% on the final exam for a statutory appointment.
2. Develop a professional development training plan in collaboration with Department of Health and Social Services staff and the Child Protection Worker who received less than 70% on the final exam to increase competencies.
3. Submit the *Recommendation for a Child Protection Worker Statutory Appointment form* to the Director of Child and Family Services for any Child Protection Worker who received less than 70% on the final exam with an approved professional development training plan for a statutory appointment.
4. Submit a *Request for Revocation of a Child Protection Worker Statutory Appointment*

form to the Director of Child and Family Services when an appointment needs to be removed.

The Child Protection Worker will:

1. Complete training and obtain 70% on the final exam.
2. Participate in the development of a training plan if less than 70% is obtained on the final exam.
