The Child Protection Worker shall take measures to ensure their safety when involved in a home visit or apprehension of a child.

PURPOSE

- To ensure the safety of Child Protection Workers when involved with children and families.

PROCEDURE


1. Assess the situation to determine potential safety threats.
2. Complete the *Child Protection Worker Safety Assessment form* and utilize the *Child Protection Worker Site Visit Sign In/Out* and *Safety Incident Report forms* when deemed necessary.
3. Discuss the results of the *Assessment* with the Supervisor.
4. Identify safety measures that will be taken if required, including requesting another staff or the RCMP to also attend the situation.
