ASSESSMENT

CCP Staff will complete a comprehensive biopsychosocial assessment of all clients, beginning at the first session with the client and on an ongoing basis.

Pathways to Wellness: An Updated Action Plan for Addictions and Mental Health 2014-2016

PURPOSE

- To gain a holistic view of the client and their needs.
- To determine the clients need for further assessment (e.g. depression, addictions, etc.).
- To determine the client's needs and directions for service.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Health and Social Services Authorities will create an assessment which includes the collection of information in the Assessment Requirements Checklist.
- 2. Meet with the client and gather information about the client, including, but not limited to the information on the Assessment Requirements Checklist.
- 3. Complete the appropriate inventory if you feel that you need additional information on a specific issue/problem.
- 4. If further assessment/psychological testing or additional services are necessary initiate the referral process.
- 5. Complete the ODARA (Ontario Domestic Assault Risk Assessment) in **all** cases of family violence when the following criteria is met (see Family Violence standards for more information on safety planning):
 - Male partner abusing female partner
 - Presence of index assault, which is the most recent incident in which the man being assessed assaulted a woman with whom he is (or was) in a relationship with (most recent on police record).
- 6. Analyze the results of any assessment tools utilized and determine the client's needs and risks.

- 7. Place completed assessment form in the client's file and document any actions taken.
- 8. Place all completed assessment inventories that were completed in the client's file with notes on the outcome of the inventory and the client's needs and risks.
