**Important: CPI #190 will replace CPI #165 NWT Clinical Practice Guidelines for Primary Community Care Nursing (June 2021).** To ensure version control, the NWT Department of Health and Social Services (Department) recommends that only the electronic version of the Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) Clinical Practice Guidelines for Primary Care Nurses working in Remote and Isolated Indigenous Communities be the standard.

### Statement of approved Clinical Practice:

The NWT Clinical Practice Guidelines for Primary Community Care Nursing website contains the approved clinical practice standards for the NWT and supersede all previous NWT Clinical Practice Guidelines for Primary Community Care Nursing.

The NWT has adopted the **Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) Clinical Practice Guidelines for Primary Care Nurses working in Remote and Isolated Indigenous Communities**, effectively replacing all previous NWT Clinical Practice Guidelines for Primary Community Care Nursing.

In instances where the ISC guidelines conflict with NWT legislation, standards, policies, or procedures, NWT sources take precedence over the ISC guidelines.


Registered Nurses apply ISC Clinical Practice Guidelines within the context of their legislated scope of practice, regulatory standards, organizational policies and in consideration of the nurse's specific role and/or position.
