Important: CPI 184 will replace the CPI #101 NWT Colorectal Screening Guidelines (March 2011).

Statement of approved Clinical Practice:

The Chief Public Health Officer and NTHSSA Medical Director have approved and are recommending the implementation of the updated 2024 NWT Colorectal Cancer Screening Clinical Practice Guidelines as a standard of practice.

These guidelines have been updated to include the following changes:

- Screening recommendations based on increasing level of risk as stratified by family and personal history.
- Standardization of a 2-year FIT interval for average risk individuals
- Recommendations for surveillance method and interval based on detailed risk classification from colonoscopy findings.
- Screening over the age of 74 years is not recommended but may be at the discretion of the healthcare provider.

These 2024 Colorectal Cancer Screening guidelines, contain the approved clinical practice standard for the NWT, and supersede all previous Colorectal Cancer Screening guidelines.
