

WHAT IS COVERED BY JORDAN'S PRINCIPLE?

Jordan's Principle covers all public services such as mental health, special education, dental, physical therapy, medical equipment, physiotherapy and more.

It is important to note that Jordan's Principle will aid the child in accessing practical services that may not be accessible due to inequality or discrimination. Jordan's Principle requests are evaluated on a case-by-case basis to cover emerging needs.

Children recognized by their Indigenous Nation, with or without status under the Indian Act, are eligible for Jordan's Principle.

A child under the age of majority in their province or territory of residence can access Jordan's Principle, if they permanently reside in Canada and if the child meets one of the following criteria:

- is registered or eligible to be registered under the Indian Act
- has one parent or guardian who is registered or
- is ordinarily resident on reserve.
- eligible to be registered under the Indian Act
- is recognized by their nation for the purposes of Jordan's Principle
