**Actual Acquisition Cost,** as defined in the agreement between the Pharmacy and Alberta Blue Cross, means the net invoice cost for a drug or drug product after deducting from the invoice cost, the value of price reductions paid or credited by the manufacturer, wholesaler, or other party to the Pharmacy.

**Pharmacy Up-Charge** means the maximum percentage charge allowed on the Actual Acquisition Cost to the cap limit.
