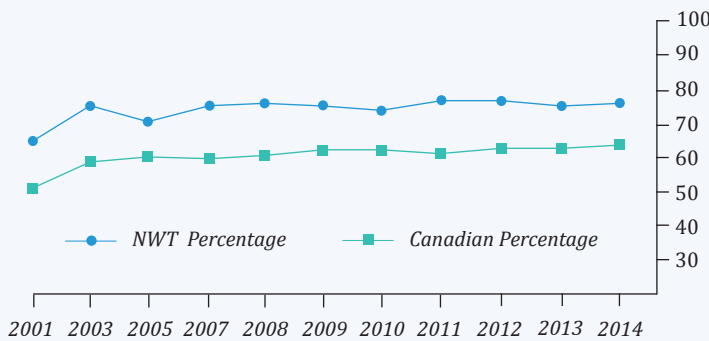

## What does sense of community belonging mean?

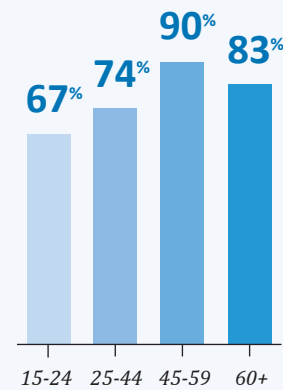

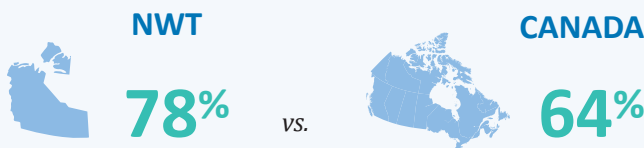

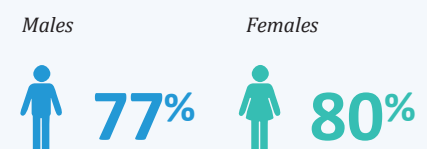
